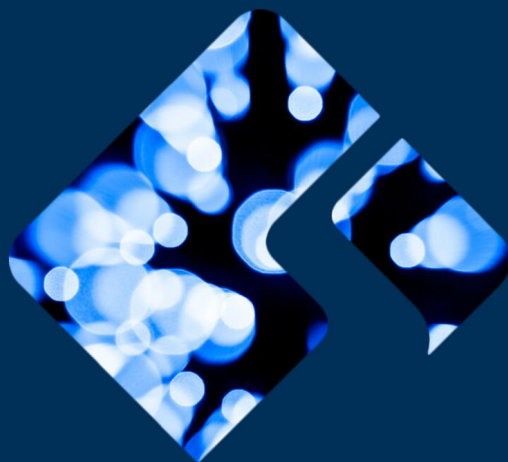




Vehicle tax is changing...



From 1st April 2017..

UK tax on newly registered vehicles is changing. Going forwards, all new cars (except for zero emission vehicles) will be subject to first year tax rates based on the CO2 emissions, followed by a standard rate of £140 in subsequent years.

In addition to this, any vehicle over £40,000 will incur an additional charge of £310 per annum for the next five years. This means that vehicles registered from 1st April 2017 priced over £40,000 will pay £450 for the next five years.

Cars registered before 1st April 2017...

Will remain in the current tax band system! Here's an example of the saving you can make if you purchase and register your new car before the change is put in place:

Mercedes-Benz C220d AMG Line Premium Plus (list price over £40,000)

Currently £0 tax year 1, £30 per year afterwards - total tax cost in 3 years ownership is £60

After 1 April 2017 £160 tax year 1, £450 per year afterwards - total tax cost in 3 years ownership is £1,060
